Bogart Mission Statement

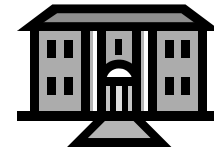

Two reminders from our Mayor and Council:

**Please do not place brush, branches, leaves and other debris in the ditches. Doing so causes the pipes and culverts to get clogged resulting in drainage problems. The Oconee County Road Department will not remove debris from the ditches. The City of Bogart will not remove leaves from the ditches when placed there by citizens. Composting and mulching is encouraged.

** Our area counties have established and adopted leash laws for pets that are honored by the City of Bogart. Please keep your animals on a leash when walking them, and please be respectful of your neighbors by keeping animals and their "leavings" from our residents' yards.

PUBLIC NOTICE

As provided for by GA laws, the City of Bogart will conduct a special election on Tuesday, March 17, 2009, during the hours of 7am until 7pm. One council seat shall be elected to fill an unexpired term to expire December 31, 2009.

Candidates desiring to qualify may do so upon the opening of business at Bogart City Hall on Tuesday, January 27, 2009 during the hours of 8:30 am until 4:00 pm, until the close of business on Thursday, January 29, 2009 at 4:00 pm. Qualifying fee for Council is \$108.

Candidates for Council must be 21 years of age and shall have resided in the city limits for 6 months preceding this election. Candidates must be registered voters and a U.S. citizen.

Deadline for residents to qualify to vote is February 16, 2009.

All citizens of the City of Bogart who are registered voters may vote in this municipal election.
